### 2025 Denver Sales Tax Rate Changes

Denver voters recently enacted a sales tax increase to support Denver Health's emergency and trauma care, primary medical care, mental health care, drug and alcohol use recovery, and pediatric care. The voter-approved initiative raises Denver's sales tax rate by 0.34% resulting in as much as \$70 million annually in additional funds for Denver Health.

**Beginning Jan. 1, 2025, all businesses must collect the new Denver sales tax rate of 5.15%\***

Begin planning now and update Point of Sale (POS) systems to support the new rate beginning Jan. 1, 2025.

The new combined sales tax rate for Denver (combined City and County of Denver, State of Colorado, RTD, and SCFD sales tax) will be 9.15% beginning Jan. 1, 2025.

\*The increase does not apply to aviation fuel, short-term car rental, and food and beverage sales tax rates, which will remain the same in 2025.
